

# Clean Acres Recovery Housing

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## Emergency Procedures

### (other than relapse)

1. Anytime a resident is asking to be taken to the emergency room or hospital for psychological reasons, and has not had a physical accident, the House Manager or designated individual will be notified by phone prior to the resident leaving the house. If there is no response by the House Manager or designated individual within ten minutes said resident should be transported via ambulance to the nearest Hospital emergency room.
2. If a resident is acting extremely peculiar, very different from normal, or threatening suicide or homicide call the House Manager, while two residents attempt to calm down said resident. Ask resident if they would like to go to the hospital for help. If yes then follow above procedure. If not have two residents continue to help calm the resident down until the House Manager responds to the call. Do not leave them alone.
3. If after several minutes if the resident cannot be calmed down, or if resident is lashing out physically towards their self or others, or is destroying objects and cannot be stopped verbally call the emergency number, 911, explain the situation, and follow their direction. Then contact the House Manager or designated individual.
4. If a resident or visitor is or has been physically abusive to another individual on the Clean Acres property call 911 immediately, explain the situation and follow their direction. Then call the House Manager or designated individual.
5. If a resident or visitor is physically hurt to an extreme call 911 immediately, explain the situation and follow their direction. Then call the House Manager or designated individual.
6. If any resident or visitor is hurt to the point that they cannot care for themselves and they are bleeding take all precautions to protect yourself from possible infection before caring for them. Follow the procedure for possible infection, call 911, explain the situation and follow their direction. Then call the House Manager or designated individual.
